Racial Justice Sunday 17th February 2019 Next Sunday is Racial Justice Sunday. The Gospel demands that we acknowledge the dignity of the human person. In our task as Christ's disciples, our responsibility is to make sure that people are treated with dignity and not exploited. Migrant communities and those suffering from racial abuse are particularly vulnerable to being drawn into unjust working conditions and labour exploitation. A second retiring collection will be used for promoting racial justice in our schools, parishes and in wider society.

Canon Francis Moran RIP Fr Francis died suddenly and unexpected on Tuesday 29th January in the Presbytery at Mortlake where he was Parish Priest. The cause of his death was heart failure and natural causes. Please pray for the repose of his soul and for his family as they mourn for him. His Funeral Mass will take place at the Cathedral on Wednesday 20th February at 12:30pm. More details will be available when all the arrangements have been finalized.
