Racial Justice Sunday 17th February 2019 Today is Racial Justice Sunday. The Gospel demands that we acknowledge the dignity of the human person. In our task as Christ's disciples, our responsibility is to make sure that people are treated with dignity and not exploited. Migrant communities and those suffering from racial abuse are particularly vulnerable to being drawn into unjust working conditions and labour exploitation. A second retiring collection will be used for promoting racial justice in our schools, parishes and in wider society.
