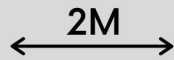


Guidelines for the Resumption of Public Mass

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS



Keep a two-metre distance between people at all times.



Stewards will be placed on the door to manage the flow of people in and out. Please follow their instructions.



Numbers will be limited based on capacity, with social distancing in mind.



Stewards will wear face coverings. You may bring and wear your own face covering if you wish.



We will keep your attendance details for 21 days for Test and Trace.



Please use the provided hand sanitiser as you enter and leave the church. The church will be cleaned between Masses.

LITURGICAL INSTRUCTIONS



Please avoid all physical contact with fellow parishioners. The Sign of Peace will not take place.



There will be no congregational singing.



There will be no offertory collection. Donations can be made as you leave the church. We encourage standing orders: see website.



No offertory procession will take place. The gifts will be brought from the credence table.



There will be no Prayers of the Faithful (Bidding Prayers).



There will be no hymn books or shared material. Readers will be encouraged not to touch the Lectionary. Parishioners can bring their own Missals.

COMMUNION



A one-way system will be marked to maintain the 2m distance during Communion.



The Precious Blood will not be distributed at this time.



Stretch your hands out as far as possible towards the priest.



Neither the priest nor the communicant will say anything at the time you receive Communion.



Please leave the church straight after you have received Communion.



Communion should be received in the hand while standing. People should be guided by the stewards, including when leaving the church.

If you have any symptoms of coronavirus or have been in contact with someone who has symptoms, please stay at home.
