COVID UPDATE AS FROM MONDAY 19th JULY:

After the Prime Minister's announcement on Monday 12th July, we have reintroduced the 9.30am Weekday Masses from 19th July and the 8am Mass from Sunday 25th July.

Wearing face masks is no longer mandatory, but I recommend that we still wear them in church, especially for the Sunday Masses. We no longer have to "track and trace" by giving your details to a steward on arrival.

I also recommend that we sanitise our hands when we come into church.

There will be no social distancing but I think it still sensible where possible to keep a distance between people.

Holy Communion will be distributed still under one kind and the Sign of Peace is suspended until further notice.

I do hope that we shall now be able to get back to some normality. It has been a very hard eighteen months. We need parishioners now to return and support our Church and Parish. I shall look forward to seeing you. Continue to keep safe and well.
