#### **COVID UPDATE AS FROM MONDAY 19<sup>th</sup> JULY:**

After the Prime Minister's announcement on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> July, we have reintroduced the 9.30am Weekday Masses from 19<sup>th</sup> July and the 8am Mass from Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> July.

Wearing face masks is no longer mandatory, but I recommend that we still wear them in church, especially for the Sunday Masses. We no longer have to "track and trace" by giving your details to a steward on arrival.

I also recommend that we sanitise our hands when we come into church.

There will be no social distancing but I think it still sensible where possible to keep a distance between people.

Holy Communion will be distributed still under one kind and the Sign of Peace is suspended until further notice.

I do hope that we shall now be able to get back to some normality. It has been a very hard eighteen months. We need parishioners now to return and support our Church and Parish. I shall look forward to seeing you. Continue to keep safe and well.
