#### **LATEST GUIDANCE FOR CHURCHES FROM THE BISHOPS' CONFERENCE OF ENGLAND AND WALES**

The following measures have been recommended by the Bishop's Conference following the ending of "Plan B" by the Government. Any one attending acts of worship are advised to still wear a face covering and it is still good practice to sanitise hands on entry and exit of churches. There is no need for formal social distancing in church buildings, although those present should be sensitive to the needs of others around them. Churches should continue to ensure good ventilation therefore the Sacred Heart Chapel will remain closed until all the restrictions are ended.

Congregational singing can resume with the general encouragement to wear face coverings whilst singing.

Hymn Books and Mass Books can be used from immediate effect.

The *Sign of Peace* may be offered and Votive candles may now be lit.

Communion must still continue to be given under one kind only.

Holy water stoups may be refilled but the water should be changed regularly.

However, if any one displaying symptoms of Covid-19 should stay at home and not participate in acts of worship and seek the appropriate medical advice.
