**MASS IN THANKSGIVING FOR FIRST HOLY COMMUNION**

At today's 10am Mass we give thanks to God for all the children in our parish who made their First Holy Communion yesterday. It is an opportunity also to thank all the Catechists who have prepared them for this great day in their lives and also their parents, families and loved ones who have supported them.

**THE RETURN OF THE SUNDAY AND HOLY DAYS OBLIGATION**

On Friday 6<sup>th</sup> May at the Plenary Assembly of the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales, it was approved that as from **Pentecost Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> June 2022 the return of the Sunday and Holy Days of Obligation comes back into force.** Consequently, online streaming of Mass and other services do not fulfil the Obligation. The Bishops have stated "It has always been the understanding of the Church that when the freedom of any Catholic to attend Mass in person is impeded for a serious reason, because of situations such as ill health, care for the sick or legitimate fear, this is not a breach of the Sunday Obligation." Consequently, 'virtual viewing' may "however, be a source of continual spiritual comfort to those who cannot attend Mass in person, for example those who are elderly and sick for whom the Obligation does not apply."
