## ST TITUS BRANDSMA, MARTYR FOR A FREE PRESS - A SAINT FOR OUR TIMES

Catholic journalist Amanda C Dickie will speak about this exceptional new saint, who was canonised by Pope Francis recently and is so relevant to our own time.
