Church and Hall heating

I am pleased to say that parishioners and I had a good meeting last Thursday about the heating repairs in the church and the parish hall. We were all in agreement over which option to pursue as set out in my letter to parishioners of Sunday 25 September. That option – Option A - was also supported by other parishioners who have approached me separately. The next step is to make a formal application to the Property and Health & Safety Committee of our Archdiocese seeking approval to press ahead. The plan is to complete the works in the church by the end of October and the works in the hall by the end of November. I shall write to you separately about the financial implications. Please continue to approach me and introduce yourselves to me.
