SPECIAL MASS FOR HIS MAJESTY KING CHARLES III ON HIS CORONATION

Friday 5 May at 7.15 pm St Catherine of Siena

The Bishops' Conference of England and Wales has requested that on Friday 5 May 2023 each parish celebrates Mass for His Majesty the King to mark his Coronation. A special liturgy has been produced with appropriate prayers for His Majesty.

At the end of Mass (after the Prayer after Communion and before the Final Blessing) the Prayer for the King is said. Copies of the Prayer will be provided.

St Catherine's will offer this Mass for His Majesty at 7.15 pm on Friday 5 May.

The Bishops' Conference has also suggested that Parishes may wish to sing a hymn of thanksgiving (the *Te Deum* or other hymn) at the end of this Mass and after Sunday Mass followed by the chant *Domine*, salvum fac and/or the National Anthem.
