REJOICE! THAT GOD HAS REVEALED HIS LOVE AND TRUTH IN THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

Today is Trinity Sunday. We can meditate on the beauty of the Blessed Trinity. It is Jesus himself who above all has revealed to us the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit as three distinct persons in one indivisible God. He speaks of the love of the Father for the Son, of the Son's desire to do the will of the Father to sacrifice himself to save us, and of the Holy Spirit's bond of truth and love with them. After the Resurrection and Ascension, the Father and the Son sent the Holy Spirit at Pentecost to fill the hearts of the faithful with love and truth, to give us a taste of heaven, and to guide his Church - the Body of Christ - through time until the end of the world and the Second Coming of Christ. This is the intense beauty, the magnificence of our Lord and God. And why has Our dear Lord Jesus revealed all this to us? So that we might love one another more and prepare ourselves for eternal love in the Blessed Trinity, and so that we may pray that all people, even our worst enemies, may be reconciled with God and enjoy eternal happiness in name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
