Sacrament of Healing – It is our duty to call a priest to
anoint family members in failing health. Please try to give
notice if at all possible and don't leave it to the last minute.
It brings consolation to the dying as well as healing to the
sick. It can be administered at church, in hospital, care
home, at home, indeed anywhere. Make sure you are
anointed before an operation with general anaesthetic.
Sacrament of Ordination and consecration to the
sacred Priesthood and Religious life – please speak to Fr
Peter who will connect you with our vocations director.

#### UPDATE ON ESSENTIAL REFURBISHMENT

Without an organiser, we won't be able to do it. We have not had such an event since 2019, because of COVID. This is a good way to raise money, to show our faith is very much alive and crucially to get to know and help one another across the parish.

# FIRST HOLY COMMUNION 2024 THE NEXT COURSE

#### **APPLICATION DEADLINE - 30 SEPTEMBER 2023**

Applications are invited for the next First Holy Communion course which will start on the first Sunday of November (the 5<sup>th</sup>) 2023, with a briefing for parents and children in mid October. Children starting Year 3 and above at school in September 2023 are eligible to apply for the course. The course will run every Sunday after the 10 am Mass (11.15 am to 12.15 am) except during holidays and half term. Attendance at Mass is essential and obligatory and is a key part of understanding the Mass and the centrality of the Eucharist in our faith. An experienced team of catechists led my Mrs Louisa Nkohkwo will take the children through the course. Parents will need to remain at church with the children for safeguarding purposes and to attend in parallel a separate course to help their children in their faith. The First Holy Communion ceremony will be on the Corpus Christi weekend: Saturday 1 June 2024 for the ceremony; Sunday 2 June for a thanksgiving Mass followed by a First Holy Communion party for the children.
