Date:

The course will begin in mid/late January 2024 with a view to holding the Confirmation ceremony later in the year when the Bishop is available to come and confer the sacrament, probably in October or November.

The Confirmation sessions will take place at St Catherine of Siena every Friday evening from 6.15 pm to 8 pm, except during holidays and half term.

We take Safeguarding seriously, and we will ensure that there will always be two adult organisers/teachers with full DBS (safeguarding) clearance at each session. Communication with the students will always take place through the parents or designated guardian, unless there are special circumstances, and then special arrangements will be made.

Confirmation is an important step in our journey of faith. The Holy Spirit imparts gifts on us which enable us to form a personal and vibrant relationship with our Lord Jesus. Each individual has to reach their own decision about whether they are ready to make a personal commitment to be a witness to the truth and love of Christ. No one should feel under any pressure to receive the Sacrament, even after attending several months of the course.

A personal commitment is nonetheless crucial, not only to attend as many sessions as possible of the course but also to attend Mass every single Sunday and Holy Days of the year, including the Holy Week Easter services. We would, therefore, be grateful if the candidate could sign this declaration below.
