TODAY'S GOSPEL REFLECTION – ARE CATHOLICS KILLING THE SON OF GOD? AN URGENT MESSAGE FOR OUR STUDENTS, TEENAGERS AND PARENTS AND FOR ALL

In your hands is the fate of our human family. Are you going to produce rich fruit or are you going to consume selfishly all the gifts given to you by God? Will you work in the vineyard of the Lord and produce the fruit for which he made you, thanking and praising God, or will you indulge yourselves, worshipping the false gods of pride, wilful ignorance of Christ, insolence, selfishness, indulging in pornography, promiscuity, fornication, rampant consumerism, denying that your divine benefactor even exists, killing his Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, in your hearts, wiping him from your minds? By not embracing the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, never going to Confession, and not living all the Sacraments, we kill the Son of God in our hearts.
