SECOND DAY OF PRAYER AND FASTING FOR PEACE IN THE MIDDLE EAST FRIDAY 27 OCTOBER - MASS FOR PEACE – 7 pm

We will offer Mass for peace and reconciliation in the Middle East in response to the call of the Holy Father last week for another day of prayer and fasting. The Holy Father went on to say, it will be "a day of penance to which I invite sisters and brothers of the various Christian denominations, those belonging to other religions, and all those who have at heart the cause of peace in the world, to join in as they see fit." On that Friday, the Holy Father will preside over a vigil in St Peter's Square at 6pm.

GIVE TO CAESAR WHAT IS CAESAR'S AND TO GOD WHAT IS GOD'S

The Bible passages today remind us that God is the God of every single human being on this planet, not just the baptised. We sometimes claim him just for ourselves. But God speaks to every one of us, and calls us by name, because we are all made in his image. We see how he uses a pagan/gentile, the great Persian King Cyrus, to liberate the Jewish people from a generation in captivity in Babylon to return to rebuild Jerusalem and its Temple as the preparation for the coming of Christ unfolds. All through salvation history and to this day, God's will is done through both Jew/Christian and gentile. By avoiding the trap laid for him by the Jewish leaders by replying to their question about Roman taxes with the words "Give to Caesar what is Caesar's and to God what is God's." Jesus is teaching us that we have an obligation to participate fully in the affairs of this world, obeying the laws of the land with integrity and honesty, while never forgetting that nothing can force us to ignore that our first obligation is to God. The key is to know our faith and put it into action.
