Forming the Garden will require the clearance of some overgrown trees and bushes, the building of a wooden fence on two sides at the rear and the building of a low brick wall - possibly a double sided low wall creating a flower bed between the two sides of the wall. Memorial plaques would be pinned to the inside of the wall where the ashes of the deceased would be buried. It is a simple evoking peace, tranquility and prayerful design contemplation.
