Sacrament of Healing – It is our duty to call a priest to anoint family members in failing health. Don't leave it to the last minute. It brings consolation to the dying as well as healing to the sick, including those suffering from mental illness and dementia. It can be administered at church, in hospital, care home, at home, indeed anywhere. Also, make sure you are anointed before an operation under a general anaesthetic.

Sacrament of Ordination and consecration to the sacred Priesthood and Religious life – speak to Fr Peter.

I am most grateful to **John Coffey** who has agreed to oversee all the projects on my behalf and specifically to manage the windows and stained glass project (see below: Art, Architecture & Buildings Group) and the Property Frontage Group (signage etc). This will enable me to focus more on developing the faith, liturgy and mission of the Parish and to move ahead with the *Holy Spirit Mission Group* which I have mentioned to you. Here is a list of our key property projects:

PROPERTY RELATED	
Project Overview & Steering Group*	To serve as a steering group across projects & activities advising the Parish Priest
Art, Architecture & Buildings Group*	To beautify the parish and to install double glazing for all church windows with stained glass in some windows.
Technology Group*	To introduce major technology to the Parish – in particular audio-visual equipment in the hall and repair of church lights.
Property Frontage Group*	To beautify road frontage and the entrance to the church estate, repair signage and introduce sacred statues.
CarParkManagement Group*	To control parking of non-parishioners and to help out the local community.
Garden Management Group*	To beautify the church estate and create a peaceful oasis with a shrine to Our Lady, Stations of the Cross etc.
Memorial Garden Group*	To create a sacred space for the burial of ashes of deceased parishioners and families.
