Sacrament of Healing – It is our duty to call a priest to anoint family members in failing health. Don't leave it to the last minute. It brings consolation to the dying as well as healing to the sick, including those suffering from mental illness and dementia. It can be administered at church, in hospital, care home, at home, indeed anywhere. Also, make sure you are anointed before an operation under a general anaesthetic.

Sacrament of Ordination and consecration to the sacred Priesthood and Religious life – speak to Fr Peter.

Dear Brothers and Sisters

Remember that this is your parish, not mine. I am your shepherd for a short while. As such I have to tell you that we rely on the weekly collection to meet our regular running costs. The fundraising events are justified by the need to manage our capital projects for the maintenance of the site, the buildings etc. Fundraising events are not meant to cover running costs. The recent generous £25k contribution from St Raphael's Surbiton cannot be used for daily expenses. You will have noticed that last week our weekly collection plummeted, because many of you are on holiday. This is a reminder to ask you not to delay to make up your contribution after your time away. **It does not count if you make your contribution to another parish you are visiting, wherever it might be.** This is your parish and it will disappear one of these days while you are away. All of us have to make a regular contribution if we can afford it. The best way for everyone to make a contribution is by **Bank Standing Order** (and if at all possible with Gift Aid at no extra cost to you). I know this is not possible for everyone. We appreciate whatever you can offer. Thank you for your patience in reading this. It is a constant cause of anxiety for me as I pray I may leave a well-managed parish for my successor in due course.

ENJOY YOUR BREAK EVERYONE – have a great time on holiday. Take your faith with you. Live as Christians not as pagans. Engage people about God if it's safe to do so. Pass it on. Express your great love of Jesus. Go to Mass if you can. It will make your holiday.

INFAMOUS BILL BROUGHT BACK

Archbishop Richard Moth, President of the Bishops' Conference, explains our strong opposition to this legislation:

"The Terminally Ill Adults (End of Life) Bill which aims to legalise assisted suicide has returned to the House of Commons, and Members of Parliament will vote on its Second Reading on 11 September. This bill is wrong in principle. It is also **deeply flawed** and, if passed, could lead to vulnerable people feeling pressured into ending their lives. The Bill has a serious lack of protection for health and social care staff and risks putting many wonderful hospices and care homes in the position of no longer being able to operate. I urge you to write to your Members of Parliament to petition them to vote against the Bill at Second Reading." Link here:
